The play revolves around a provocative face-to-face encounter between a professor and student and the “fall-out” that results from this turbulent meeting.

A unique piece of theater, *Oleanna* lets the audience observe this meeting between the professor and student, then Mamet’s play interprets and re-interprets the event in alarming and, often, unsettling ways. The result is a nightmarish, yet plausible vision of political correctness; it may be the most controversial play written in more than a generation.

This 90-minute play is sure to spark discussions for hours and days to come. “You can’t talk about it unless you’ve seen it.”
